COGIC BLACK HISTORY



MEET BISHOP G.E PATTERSON

GILBERT EARL PATTERSON SERVED AS THE <u>PRESIDING BISHOP</u> OF THE <u>CHURCH OF GOD IN CHRIST</u> (COGIC) FROM 2000 TO 2007. PATTERSON WAS THE SECOND YOUNGEST PERSON TO EVER BE ELECTED PRESIDING BISHOP OF COGIC AT THE AGE OF 60 IN 2000. SECOND TO HIS PREDECEASED UNCLE BISHOP J. O. PATTERSON SR., WHO WAS 56 WHEN HE WAS ELECTED PRESIDING BISHOP IN 1968.

PISHOP PATTERSON WAS FAMOUSLY KNOWN ACROSS MANY CHRISTIAN DENOMINATIONS FOR BEING AN EDUCATED PENTECOSTAL-CHARISMATIC PREACHER AND THEOLOGIAN, AND KNOWN FOR HIS ELOQUENT AND MUSICALLY CHARISMATIC PREACHING STYLE.

God deserves our praise because we are wonderfully made in His image.


How does God feel about you?







9 Facts About Black History Month


In 1915, historian Carter G. Woodson co-founded the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History.



Carter G. Woodson is considered to be the Father of Black History, as he was the son of former slaves and knew how important education was to secure freedom.



11 years later, the group declared the second week of February as "Negro History Week" to recognize the contributions of African Americans.





Prior to this, few people studied Black history and it wasn't included in textbooks.





Often referred to as "The Black National Anthem," Lift Every Voice and Sing was a hymn written as a poem by NAACP leader James Weldon Johnsonin 1900.

True to our native land







9 Facts About Black History Month


They chose this week because it celebrated the birthdays of Frederick Douglass, an abolitionist, and Abraham Lincoln.



It wasn't until 1976 that president Gerald Ford extended the week to a whole month, creating Black History Month.














